REVIEW THE MISSION

Have someone read one (or all) of these verses! (John 20:21 and 2 Corinthians 5:18-20)

• Who is someone who needs God's love and how can we show it to them?

Want Family Mission Ideas? Here is one that relates to this week's lesson!

Conduct a strength competition as a family.
 Gather objects of various weights to see
 who can lift the heaviest or most objects.
 Talk about the power of the Holy Spirit and how it is greater than human strength.
 Remind kids that every believer is empowered by the Holy Spirit to live for Jesus and to share Him with others.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together as a family. You can pray short prayers like, "God, thank you for" or "God, help me with" or "God, I'm sorry for..."
