#### Discuss it!

### ENGAGE THE HEART

Have someone read one (or all) of these verses. (John 15:4, James 5:16, 1 John 1:5-10, 1 John 1:9)

- How do you need God's help this week?
- Is there any sin we need to confess to Jesus and ask Him to forgive us?

### **REVIEW THE MISSION**

Have someone read one (or all) of these verses! (John 20:21 and 2 Corinthians 5:18-20)

• Who is someone who needs God's love and how can we show it to them?

Want Family Mission Ideas? Here is one that relates to this week's lesson!

 Make a list of family, friends, or acquaintances who need to hear about Jesus. Talk about ways your family can use your relationship to help them learn more about Jesus. Ask God to give opportunities for you to tell them about Jesus. Pray that each person would respond by believing in Jesus.

## PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together as a family. You can pray short prayers like, "God, thank you for" or "God, help me with" or "God, I'm sorry for…"

In light of our lesson, ask God to help you see opportunities to share Jesus with others today. What are some reasons why someone might not know about Jesus? What are some ways you can tell them about Jesus?
