SCRIPTURE: Acts 9:1-20

LESSON: A New Friend



INTRO

Parents say to your kid(s) - Last month we learned about Peter and Dorcas (Tabitha), do you remember how Dorcas' friends felt when she got sick? (Sad!) Do you remember how they felt when Peter made her better again? (Happy!) This week, we are going to learn about a new story!

Nothin' to See Here - Kids love to learn in concrete ways. This activity is a simple object lesson to help your kids interact with the Bible story they're about to learn. Supplies: Flashlight

Find the darkest room in the house! This could be a small room with no windows or even a bathroom or a closet. Use the flashlight to shine around the lit room, help kids to look at the light safely, shining it on their hands or into dark corners and seeing how bright the light is. Then turn the flashlight and all of the other lights off and help kids try to find their way around in the darkness (use a blindfold if you can't make the room dark enough).

Say - Today we are going to learn about a man who saw a very bright light, even brighter than our flashlight and then he couldn't see anything for three whole days!



LESSON - A NEW FRIEND

One of the most important ways we get to disciple kids is by teaching God's Word and how it points to Jesus. Our preschoolers are going through the God Loves Me Storybooks. These books tell the story of Scripture over 12 books, one for each month of the year. For one month kids hear and interact with the same story so that they can learn it well! Each week there is a different activity for the story.

Read the Story: A New Friend

Questions - Use these questions to review the story after you read.

- What did Paul want to do to Jesus' friends? Put them in prison
- Who talked to Paul through the bright light? Jesus
- How long was Paul blind for? Three Days
- What did he do while he was blind? Prayed
- What did Paul do after he prayed? He told everyone that Jesus loves them too!

Say - God wants us all to be His friends!.







RFSPONSF

Parents say to your kid(s) - It's good to respond to learning about Jesus in the Bible. Sometimes we sing because Jesus is worthy of our songs. Sometimes we pray because we need help and God says we can talk to Him about anything! We can also do another activity that relates to our lesson!

BONUS ACTIVITIES

Hopscotch - The classic game! Use tape inside or chalk outside to create a path of alternating single and double squares. Toss a small beanbag or pebble onto the row of squares. Hop using one foot on the single squares and two feet on the double squares to pick up what you threw. Hop back and let the next person take a turn.

Tape Obstacle Course - This activity is great for working on gross motor skills. Use painters tape to create lines, zigzags, and dots on the floor. Have kids walk through the course only on the tape, following the lines and zigzags and jumping to the dots. Have fun seeing how fast they can get through it.
