SCRIPTURE: John 4:3-32

**LESSON:** The Greatest Gift



### **INTRO**

**Parents say to your kid(s) -** Last week we learned more about Jesus telling a woman about God's love, and we made our own well! This week we are going to see what we can remember about the story!

**Object Lesson - Spreading Colors** 

Supplies: Different colors of food coloring, cups (one for each color), Paper towels Fill each cup about halfway with water and add a few drops of food coloring to each cup. Set them in a row and add a strip of paper towel between each of the cups so that the ends are touching the water in two of the cups. The colored water will start to move across the paper towel and will spread to all of the cups.

**Say -** Jesus told the woman about God's love, and she then told a whole town, and the news of God's love kept spreading everywhere.



## LESSON - THE GREATEST GIFT

One of the most important ways we get to disciple kids is by teaching God's Word and how it points to Jesus. Our preschoolers are going through the God Loves Me Storybooks. These books tell the story of Scripture over 12 books, one for each month of the year. For one month kids hear and interact with the same story so that they can learn it well! Each week there is a different activity for the story.

This is Week 4 of our story, The Greatest Gift, when we have the kids tell the story. Use the pdf below to show them the pictures on each page and have your children tell you what's happening. After you have gone through the entire story, ask some of the questions below.

Parents say to your kid(s) - We're going to read our story, The Greatest Gift!

Book: The Greatest Gift

#### Questions

- Where was the woman from? Samaria, or she was Samaritain
- What did she offer to the tired stranger? A drink of water
- What did the stranger offer her? God's love
- Who was the stranger? Jesus
- Who did the woman tell to come see Jesus? Everyone in the town!







## **RESPONSE**

**Parents say to your kid(s) -** It's good to respond to learning about Jesus in the Bible. Sometimes we sing because Jesus is worthy of our songs. Sometimes we pray because we need help and God says we can talk to Him about anything! We can also do another activity that relates to our lesson!

## **BONUS ACTIVITIES**

**Hopscotch -** The classic game! Use tape inside or chalk outside to create a path of alternating single and double squares. Toss a small beanbag or pebble onto the row of squares. Hop using one foot on the single squares and two feet on the double squares to pick up what you threw. Hop back and let the next person take a turn.

**Paper Plate Ring Toss -** Use Paper plates and the cardboard roll from a paper towel to create this easy and fun game. Glue or tape the cardboard tube to the bottom of one paper plate so that it stands upright on the floor or a table. Cut the centers of the paper plates out to create rings and have fun decorating them. Start tossing your new rings to toss to the stand that you made. Add some challenge by taking a step back after each toss or assigning points to different rings or different places in the room.
