LESSON: The Greatest Gift

INTRO

Parents say to your kid(s) - This is our last week learning about our story of Jesus meeting the Samaritan Woman! That means that this week we will have a special celebration!

What Do You Remember? - Part of our lesson today involves a craft, so for this section, take a few minutes to have kids retell the story to you.

LESSON - THE GREATEST GIFT

One of the most important ways we get to disciple kids is by teaching God's Word and how it points to Jesus. Our preschoolers are going through the God Loves Me Storybooks. These books tell the story of Scripture over 12 books, one for each month of the year. For one month kids hear and interact with the same story so that they can learn it well! Each week there is a different activity for the story.

This is Week 5 of our story, The Greatest Gift, when we have a story party! Take some time to do a special snack or special craft for this lesson.

Parents say to your kid(s) - We're going to read our story, *The Greatest Gift!*

Snack - Well Crispies!

Supplies - Rice Krispie Treats, blue sprinkles

Use premade Rice Krispie Treats as a well by creating a divot in the center of each treat. Pour the blue sprinkles into the well to be the water. Or you can [make your own](#) Rice Krispie Treats. Use a muffin tin to bake the treats to create small cups to be the well. Add sprinkles to be the water and enjoy your well!

Craft - Living Water

Supplies - Paper or styrofoam cup, yarn, blue paper

Decorate your styrofoam cup like a well. Cut water droplets out of the blue paper. Write one word from the end of John 6:35 on each droplet, "Whoever believes in me will never be thirsty." Use a holepunch or a pencil to punch holes in the top of each drop. String the yarn through each of the droplets. Punch a hole in the top of the cup and tie the end of the string through the hole. Now the water is coming out of the well.





RESPONSE

Parents say to your kid(s) - It's good to respond to learning about Jesus in the Bible. Sometimes we sing because Jesus is worthy of our songs. Sometimes we pray because we need help and God says we can talk to Him about anything! We can also do another activity that relates to our lesson!

BONUS ACTIVITIES

Animal Charades - Pick one person to be the actor. They will stand in front of everyone and pretend to be an animal while everyone else guesses what kind of animal they are. Once the animal has been guessed correctly, the next person takes a turn pretending to be a new animal.

Freeze Dance - Turn on some tunes and get to dancing! But be careful, when the music stops you have to freeze! If anyone moves while the music is off, they are out.
