SCRIPTURE: Mark 8:22-26

LESSON: A Wonderful Sight



INTRO

Parents say to your kid(s) - This month, we're learning about a time when Jesus healed a blind man and this is our last week learning about this story. Today we are going to see what we can remember from the story!

Object Lesson - Sit in a dark room. Draw the curtains, turn off the lights, make the room as dark as possible and sit in it for a few minutes. How do you feel? What do you see? Think about why we are afraid of the dark. What is not fun and scary about not being able to see what's in front of you? Now turn the lights back on, open the curtains and be in the light. The colors seem brighter than they did before! The light probably feels extra good and comforting after sitting in the dark. What is so good about being able to see?

Say - Not being able to see was probably a little scary. But then when we turned the lights back on they seemed even better than before. When Jesus healed this man who couldn't see, he went from living in total darkness all of the time to living in light!



LESSON - A WONDERFUL SIGHT!

One of the most important ways we get to disciple kids is by teaching God's Word and how it points to Jesus. Our preschoolers are going through the God Loves Me Storybooks. These books tell the story of Scripture over 12 books, one for each month of the year. For one month kids hear and interact with the same story so that they can learn it well! Each week there is a different activity for the story.

Parents say to your kid(s) - Today we are going to read our story A Wonderful Sight, and see what we can remember from the story!

Questions -

This final week of our lesson, we see what kids can remember from our story, see what they can retell to you from the story on their own first and then use these questions to prompt them when they get stuck.

- What was it that the man couldn't do? *See*
- What did the man's friends do for him? *They brought him to Jesus*
- What did Jesus do to the man? *He touched his eyes*
- What was the first thing the man could see when Jesus touched his eyes? *Colors*
- What could the man finally do because of Jesus? *See!*

Read Book: [A Wonderful Sight](#)

Say - Jesus healed this man from his blindness and He wants to help us see His goodness when we have a hard time remembering how good He is.



RESPONSE

Parents say to your kid(s) - It's good to respond to learning about Jesus in the Bible. Sometimes we sing because Jesus is worthy of our songs. Sometimes we pray because we need help and God says we can talk to Him about anything! We can also do another activity that relates to our lesson!

Parent Share - In this story, there was a time when the man was partially blind and could partially see. when is a time that you have been able to half understand something, but then Jesus helped you see more clearly later?



BONUS ACTIVITIES

M&M Rainbow - *Supplies: M&M's or Skittles, a plate, water*

Line up your colored candy around the edges of the plate. Make a fun pattern with the colors or organize them so that the same colors are together. When you have created a circle around the edge of your plate, pour water into the middle until it reaches the candies. Watch a beautiful rainbow magically move towards the center of the plate on the water.

Sponge Tag - *Supplies: Large sponges, a bucket of water*

A great game for a warm day. Everyone gets a large sponge and starts with it wet from the bucket of water. Choose one person to be it and then begin playing tag, but instead of tagging with your hands, you have to use the sponge! Whoever can stay dry the longest wins!
