**SCRIPTURE:** Mark 8:22-26

LESSON: A Wonderful Sight



#### INTRO

**Parents say to your kid(s)** - Last week, we had a party for our story about Jesus meeting a woman and telling her about the greatest gift, God's Love! Today we are going to start learning a new story. Hooray!

#### **Object Lesson - Surprise Rainbow!**

Supplies: Paper towel, black sharpie, washable markers, a bowl of water

This can be a fun surprise with just a few minutes of prep, or a fun activity to do with your kids!


**Step 1:** Fold the paper towel in half.

**Step 2:** Using the black sharpie, draw the outlines of a rainbow, press down and go over the lines a few times so that it bleeds onto the other half of the paper towel.

**Step 3:** On the bottom layer, color in the rainbow with washable markers.

**Step 4:** Fold the paper towel back so the black and white rainbow covers the colored rainbow. If you are doing this as a surprise, now is the time to bring your kids over to your bowl of water. Drop the folded paper towel into the water with the black and white side up. Watch the colors of your rainbow appear!

(If you need more clarity,, <u>here</u> is a video demonstration. Start at 37 seconds in -about half way.)



**Say** - It was so exciting when we saw our colors appear on the rainbow. Today we are learning about a time when Jesus healed a man who could not see at all. How exciting would it have been to see colors for the first time?!!



## LESSON - A WONDERFUL SIGHT!

One of the most important ways we get to disciple kids is by teaching God's Word and how it points to Jesus. Our preschoolers are going through the God Loves Me Storybooks. These books tell the story of Scripture over 12 books, one for each month of the year. For one month kids hear and interact with the same story so that they can learn it well! Each week there is a different activity for the story.

Parents say to your kid(s) - We're going to read our story, A Wonderful Sight!

Book: A Wonderful Sight

#### **Ouestions** -

- What couldn't the man in the story do? See
- What did Jesus do to make the man see again? He touched his eyes
- What could the man see after Jesus touched his eyes? Shapes and Colors

**Say -** Jesus could heal people who couldn't be healed by doctors. This man was waiting a long time and was so happy when he could finally see!







### **RFSPONSF**

**Parents say to your kid(s)** - It's good to respond to learning about Jesus in the Bible. Sometimes we sing because Jesus is worthy of our songs. Sometimes we pray because we need help and God says we can talk to Him about anything! We can also do another activity that relates to our lesson!

**Coloring Sheet -** <u>Printable Coloring Sheet</u> of Jesus healing the man.

Parent Share - Tell your children what your favorite color is and why!

## **BONUS ACTIVITIES**

**Rainbow Rice** - Supplies: Rice, white vinegar, food coloring, parchment paper In a ziplock bag, combine I cup of white rice, 1.2 tsp of white vinegar, and a few drops of food coloring. Seal the bag and mix the contents thoroughly. Repeat for each desired color. Spread rice out on parchment paper and allow it to dry overnight. Have fun mixing the colors of rice together in a bowl or tupperware!

**Story Go Round -** Make up a story together. Everyone takes turns adding one word to the story until you have a wacky and funny story.
