SCRIPTURE: Mark 8:22-26

LESSON: *A Wonderful Sight*



INTRO

Parents say to your kid(s) - This month, we're learning about a time when Jesus healed a blind man and we acted out the story together. Today we are going to experience the story even more.

Object Lesson - Walk around the room with your eyes closed. Try to complete a task without looking, it is pretty difficult, isn't it? Open your eyes. The colors and the light seem even better and brighter when you have had your eyes closed for a long time.

Say - It was pretty hard to do things when we couldn't see, wasn't it? The man in the story had a lot of practice doing things without being able to see, but his life was still probably pretty difficult. Jesus made it so that this man could see and that changed his life completely!



LESSON - A WONDERFUL SIGHT!

One of the most important ways we get to disciple kids is by teaching God's Word and how it points to Jesus. Our preschoolers are going through the God Loves Me Storybooks. These books tell the story of Scripture over 12 books, one for each month of the year. For one month kids hear and interact with the same story so that they can learn it well! Each week there is a different activity for the story.

Parents say to your kid(s) - Today we are going to read our story *A Wonderful Sight*, and then we are going to do a craft together!

Craft - Paper Plate Puppet

Supplies - paper plate, markers, google eyes

Use markers to draw a face on one side of the paper plate. Draw hair, a nose, a mouth and eyes that are closed. Make this as simple or elaborate as you like. On the flip side of the plate, draw a face and use the googly eyes as the open eyes. Note: If you don't have googly eyes, just draw the eyes open. Go through the story and flip your plate puppets when Jesus heals the blind man.

Read Book: [*A Wonderful Sight*](#)

Say - When Jesus healed the man and restored his sight, He changed His life forever. That's what Jesus does. People are never the same after they truly meet Him.



RESPONSE

Parents say to your kid(s) - It's good to respond to learning about Jesus in the Bible. Sometimes we sing because Jesus is worthy of our songs. Sometimes we pray because we need help and God says we can talk to Him about anything! We can also do another activity that relates to our lesson!

The person who is "it" closes their eyes and begins searching for people to tag by saying "Marco" to which everyone else replies "Polo". The person uses the sound of everyone else's voices to find someone to tag. When someone is tagged, they become "it".
