SCRIPTURE: John 6:1-13

LESSON: A Little Lunch



INTRO

Parents say to your kid(s) - This month, we are learning about a time when Jesus fed a large crowd with just a small amount of food in our story *A Little Lunch*!

Multiplying Corners - Kids love to learn in concrete ways. This activity is a simple object lesson to help your kids interact with the Bible story they're about to learn. Supplies: a piece of paper, scissors

Ask kids how many corners the piece of paper has. Cut one of the corners off and ask how many corners there are now. Continue cutting corners off until you have many corners.

Say - The more Jesus divided the bread to give it away, the more He had to give away. He didn't run out of food until everyone had plenty to eat. In middle school,



IFSSON - A LITTLE LUNCH

One of the most important ways we get to disciple kids is by teaching God's Word and how it points to Jesus. Our preschoolers are going through the God Loves Me Storybooks. These books tell the story of Scripture over 12 books, one for each month of the year. For one month kids hear and interact with the same story so that they can learn it well! Each week there is a different activity for the story.

Read Book: A Little Lunch

Act It Out - Sit together while you read the story like people would sit and listen to Jesus teach. Then have everyone pretend to be very hungry, holding their stomachs and making faces. Get a very small amount of food that is obviously not enough for everyone. Ask, "Is this enough to feed everyone if we are very hungry?" Everyone should answer with "No!"

Say - When the boy brought food to Jesus, everyone thought it would not be enough food, but Jesus miraculously multiplied the food so that everyone could eat and have enough!







RFSPONSF

Parents say to your kid(s) - It's good to respond to learning about Jesus in the Bible. Sometimes we sing because Jesus is worthy of our songs. Sometimes we pray because we need help and God says we can talk to Him about anything! We can also do another activity that relates to our lesson!

Sing: This Little Light of Mine

Coloring Sheet - <u>Printable Coloring Sheet</u> of Jesus feeding the people. .

Parent Share - The crowd in this story was surprised by Jesus providing for them. Tell about a time when you were surprised by God's provision for you!



BONUS ACTIVITIES

Baking - Bake bread, cupcakes, or cookies with your child. As you eat them imagine what it would have been like to receive the food that Jesus had multiplied.

Freeze Dance - Turn on some of your child's favorite tunes and have fun dancing to the music, but be careful, when the music stops, you have to freeze!
