**DATE:** 7/26/20

**SCRIPTURE:** John 6:1-13

**LESSON:** A Little Lunch



### INTRO

**Parents say to your kid(s)** - This is the last week we are going to read our story *A Little Lunch*. We are going to see what we can remember from the story!

**Object Lesson** - Kids love to learn in concrete ways. This activity is a simple object lesson to help your kids interact with the Bible story they're about to learn.

Brave the heat and take a walk outside to look at some flowers. Tell kids about how flowers don't make clothes or go to the store to buy clothes but they are so beautiful because God makes them beautiful. Tell them about how flowers cannot walk to the store to get food or cook food for themselves, but God provides sunlight and rain so that they can grow.

**Say** - In our story this month we have been learning about a time when a group of people could not get food for themselves so God provided for them just like He provides for the flowers we looked at!



### LESSON - A LITTLE LUNCH

One of the most important ways we get to disciple kids is by teaching God's Word and how it points to Jesus. Our preschoolers are going through the God Loves Me Storybooks. These books tell the story of Scripture over 12 books, one for each month of the year. For one month kids hear and interact with the same story so that they can learn it well! Each week there is a different activity for the story.

**Questions** - Ask these questions before reading the story to see what kids can remember.

- What was the large crowd doing? *Listening to Jesus*
- What did they need? *Food*
- How many fish were in the little boy's lunch? *Two*
- What did Jesus do before he shared the food? *He thanked God for it*
- Were the people hungry after Jesus passed out the food? *No*

**Say** - Jesus did an amazing miracle, He provided food for a huge crowd with just a little bit of food! He wants to provide for you too!



## RESPONSE

**Parents say to your kid(s)** - It's good to respond to learning about Jesus in the Bible. Sometimes we sing because Jesus is worthy of our songs. Sometimes we pray because we need help and God says we can talk to Him about anything! We can also do another activity that relates to our lesson!

## BONUS ACTIVITIES

**Copy Dance** - This is a fun and silly game to get some energy out! Choose some fun music to listen to and pick one person to be "it". That person starts dancing and everyone else copies their dance moves. Change who is "it" with each song.

**Make a Book** - Children have so many stories to tell and only need help writing it all down. Fold paper in half and staple at the crease to make pages. After the story is written, go back and read it to the child so they can illustrate each page!
