DATE: 8/23/20 SCRIPTURE: Luke 15:3-7 LESSON: A Lost Lamb

INTRO

Parents say to your kid(s) - We have been learning about our story *A Lost Lamb*. Today we are going to see how much you've learned! You're gonna help teach me the lesson and see how much you remember about the story.

Found! - Kids love to learn in concrete ways. This activity is a simple object lesson to help your kids interact with the Bible story they're about to learn. Hide toy coins, real coins, or chocolate coins throughout the house and go o a treasure hunt to find them. Celebrate together each time you find a coin.

Say - Just like we looked high and low to find every coin that was hidden, the Good Shepherd looked EVERYWHERE for His lost lamb.



LESSON - A LOST LAMB

One of the most important ways we get to disciple kids is by teaching God's Word and how it points to Jesus. Our preschoolers are going through the God Loves Me Storybooks. These books tell the story of Scripture over 12 books, one for each month of the year. For one month kids hear and interact with the same story so that they can learn it well! Each week there is a different activity for the story.

Have the Kids Teach the Story: <u>A Lost Lamb</u>

 For today's lesson go through page by page and ask the kids on each page "What's happening here?" or "Remind me how this story goes?"

Questions - Afterwards, here are some helpful review questions:

- What book in the Bible is this story from? *Luke*
- Who told the story of the lost lamb? Jesus
- How did the sheep know the shepherd loved them? He took care of them
- What happened to the little lamb in the story? He got lost
- What did the shepherd do when he had found his sheep? *He told everyone and celebrated!*

Say - The Shepherd was so glad when He found His lost sheep He told all of His neighbors about it and celebrated that His sheep was found!







RESPONSE

Parents say to your kid(s) - It's good to respond to learning about Jesus in the Bible. Sometimes we sing because Jesus is worthy of our songs. Sometimes we pray because we need help and God says we can talk to Him about anything! We can also do another activity that relates to our lesson!

Sing: <u>Peace Like a River</u> Looking at my Heart

Coloring Sheet - Printable Coloring Sheet of the Good Shepherd and the lost lamb.

Parent Share - What do you do when you have found something that was lost?



BONUS ACTIVITIES

Freeze Dance - Turn on some tunes and get to dancing! But be careful, when the music stops you have to freeze! If anyone moves while the music is off, they are out.

Bubble Art - Supplies: bubble solution (or make your own like <u>this</u>), A bubble wand, food coloring, plastic cups, paper

This activity can get a little messy, so it is a great one to do outside! You will need a plastic cup for each color that you want to make. Pour a quarter cup or more of the bubble solution into the plastic cups. Mix in about 5 drops of the desired food coloring, repeat this for each color. Stir the food coloring into the bubble solution carefully. Then take the bubble wand and dip it into the cups, blow bubbles onto your paper to create beautiful artwork!
