LESSON: God is Greater Than Your

Insecurities

INTRO

This conversation guide exists to help parents interact with their middle and high school students. Our goal is to help them transition toward being adults, but most middle and high school students still need some translation and help connecting what we're learning on Sundays to their lives.

- Ice Breakers:

- How would you define insecurity in your own words? What kinds of things are you insecure about? (Parents go first!)

- Sermon Discussion:

- What is something that stood out to you from the sermon?
- **Read Exodus 3:9-11.** What do you think about Moses feeling like this? Do you ever feel like this? "Who am I to do this thing? God you could find someone better than me to do this?"
 - What ways do you see the world trying to fix insecurities? Where do you see these not working?
- **Read Exodus 3:12-14.** How is God's response to insecurities different from the World's response? Why is it better?
 - Is it easy or difficult to believe that God is with you and that is enough?
- **Parent Share:** Tell about a time when you stepped out of your comfort zone despite your insecurities because you knew God was with you.
