LESSON: God is Not Small

INTRO

This conversation guide exists to help parents interact with their middle and high school students. Our goal is to help them transition toward being adults, but most middle and high school students still need some translation and help connecting what we're learning on Sundays to their lives.

- Ice Breakers:

- What do you know about the story of Job?

- Sermon Discussion:

- What is something that stood out to you from the sermon?
- What kinds of things do you question God about? (i.e. a particular circumstance, a loss, a doubt, a frustration, etc.)
- **Read Job 38: 1-4.** What do these questions that God asks tell you about God? What do they tell you about yourself/humanity?
 - How does remembering how big God is and how small we are help us handle our doubts, frustrations and questions? (Parents: Emphasize that humility and trust are the key to our questions being helpful and not unhelpful accusations)
 - How can you tell the difference between humble questions for God and arrogant accusations against God?
- **Parent Share:** Have there been times when you have questioned God? Tell your student about these times. What helped you to trust God's power and love for you?
