LESSON: God is Greater Than Your

View of Him

INTRO

This conversation guide exists to help parents interact with their middle and high school students. Our goal is to help them transition toward being adults, but most middle and high school students still need some translation and help connecting what we're learning on Sundays to their lives.

- Ice Breakers:
 - What are the attributes that come to mind when you think about God?
- Sermon Discussion:
 - What is something that stood out to you from the sermon?
 - **Read Exodus 32:1-6.** What was the problem with what the Israelites did here? Why do you think they did it?
 - Can you think of any ways you (or other people you know) try to make your own version of God based on what you think He should be like?
 - What is the problem with creating a God that emphasizes your preferences about what God should be and ignores the reality of who God is?
 - **Read 1 Corinthians 1:15.** Are there things you believe to be true about God that don't line up with the reality of who Jesus is?
- **Parent Share:** Tell your students about a time you had a false perception of God and how He corrected you with a fuller image of who He is. What helps point you to the truth when you are tempted to believe false ideas about who God is?
