Isaiah, Prophet to Judah

Bible Passage: Isaiah 6, 53

REVIEW THE STORY

- **1.) Kids who can tell me about the story you learned about on Sunday?** (Pause and let them think of what they can remember.)
- **2.) Does anyone remember the main characters?** (Pause... If they can't remember, help lead them to remember ... as they remember encourage them!)
 - Isaiah, God, the people of Judah
- 3.) Ok, does anyone remember any of the story points?

Story Point #1: God opened Isaiah's eyes to see his sin.

Story Point #2: Isaiah was willing to tell people about God's plan.

Story Point #3: God's plan was to send a Messiah to save the world from sin.

4.) Awesome, and can anyone remember how this story connected to Jesus?

TALK THROUGH THE STORY POINTS:

Story Point #1: God opened Isaiah's eyes to see his sin.

- What did the angels call out in worship to God? (Basic comprehension Help the kids recap from the lesson.)
- What sin do you struggle with that you know you need God's help with? (Adults answer first... then let the kids answer. Give them the gift of going second!)

Story Point #2: Isaiah was willing to tell people about God's plan.

- How cool is it that God asks sinners, like Isaiah and like you and me, to join Him in His plans?! What is a way that God has used you to help or encourage someone else? (Adults answer first, then kids)
- For Isaiah, he knew that the people weren't going to like his message very much. What is something God asks you to do that's difficult? (Adults answer first, then kids)

Story Point #3: God's plan was to send a Messiah to save the world from sin.

- What is a "Messiah"? An anointed one, a chosen one, a savior.





REVIEW THE CHRIST CONNECTION:

Christ Connection: Jesus is the Messiah! He is God's plan to save the world from sin!

- Adults - How is that good news to you? In what parts of life do you most need to remember that God sent Jesus to save the world from sin?

PRAYFR TIMF:

Pray and thank God for sending Jesus as the Messiah to save the world from sin. Pray and ask Jesus to continually open our eyes to see our sin and to receive His forgiveness and grace for our sin.

PRACTICE THE KEY PASSAGE:*

If My people, who bear My name, humble themselves, pray and seek My face, and turn from their evil ways, then I will hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and heal their land.
